ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A vear end school report for Grade 9 or Higher An NQF Level 1 qualification
- An approved bridging programme to access NQF Level 2
- RPL assessment to meet requirements

Duration of course: The National Certificate (Vocational) course is a full year programme with seven subjects at each of the NQF levels of study. A student is issued with a certificate on the successful completion of each level of study.
